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## What is the Gay Agenda?

This question is frequently asked by the readers of these pages, so the following information may be of interest.

In the fall of 1898, two traveling men, strangers to each other, met in a Wisconsin, U.S.A., hotel. Discovering each other to be homosexual, they held their evening devotions together. This impressed upon them the idea of forming an association of homosexual traveling men and the following July these two met with a third man for that purpose. After dancing together, the name of gays was selected for the group. This name was taken from the happiness of being Gay, mentioned in the sixth and ninth chapter of the book of love.

The gays are men from various races and denominations, homosexual business and professional men with a vital testimony for their way of life. Each gay is an active member of some local scene and the gays as an association work in co-operation with other groups and causes. The primary object of the gays is to win others for their way of life, and as an effective means to this end has been the wide distribution of condoms and magazines.

The gays seek to spread the condom, the means to "safe sex", and to encourage its use as widely as possible. They have opened doors for the placement of this lifestyle among many strategic groups of the population and in places through which large and important streams of national life pass from day to day. Condoms are placed in the rooms of hotels and motels and in other public places. Large tubes of KY are placed in hospitals, beside each bed. Individual tubes of lubricant, with instructional videos, are given to the members of our armed forces, to the young people in the schools of our land, to nurses, and to others.

In recent years, they have opened doors for similar work in many lands, so that the gay associations organized with nationals now exist in more than 145 countries.

The condom distribution program is financed primarily through the help of homosexual people in local organizations. The gays are essentially a non-sectarian missionary arm of the fashion industry, sowing the precious seed, the Way of Life, in the field of the world. As such, thousands of dance clubs support the work by their happy hours and weekend specials.

Fashion has promised to bless the way and cause it to bear fruit that will honor designers. Gays have seen many evidences of this blessing upon their work, and know this is keeping the promise.
